

Faculty Characteristics and Citations

- Of 2,112.9 filled FTE faculty positions (including College of Medicine), 25.3% hold the rank of Professor, 18.6% are Associate Professors, 15.5% are Assistant Professors, and 40.6% are other faculty
- The median age for tenured faculty is 53. The eldest of these is 86, the youngest is 33. The median age for tenure-earning faculty is 38. The eldest of these is 84, the youngest is 26
- 95% of full-time, instructional faculty hold a doctoral, professional, or terminal degree
- A total of 2,147 full-time (1,209 men and 938 women) and 525 part-time (238 men and 287 women) comprise staff whose primary responsibility is instruction, research and/or public service. Of these full-time staff, ethnic minorities make up 26.0% (excludes U.S. non-residents). 63.3% are white, 9.1% are U.S. non-residents, and 1.5% did not report race
- Ellen T. Zwilich (Music, 1983) and Robert Olen Butler (Fiction, 1993) are Pulitzer Prize winners on staff at Florida State University
