Enrollment by Fall Semester



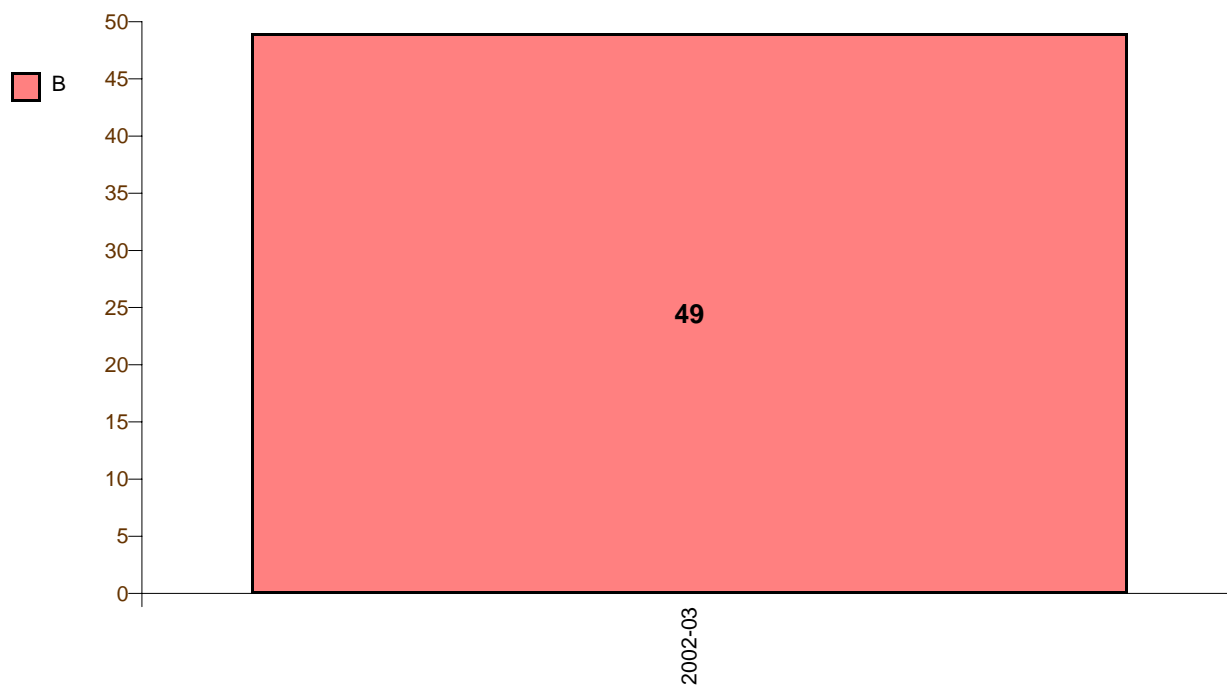

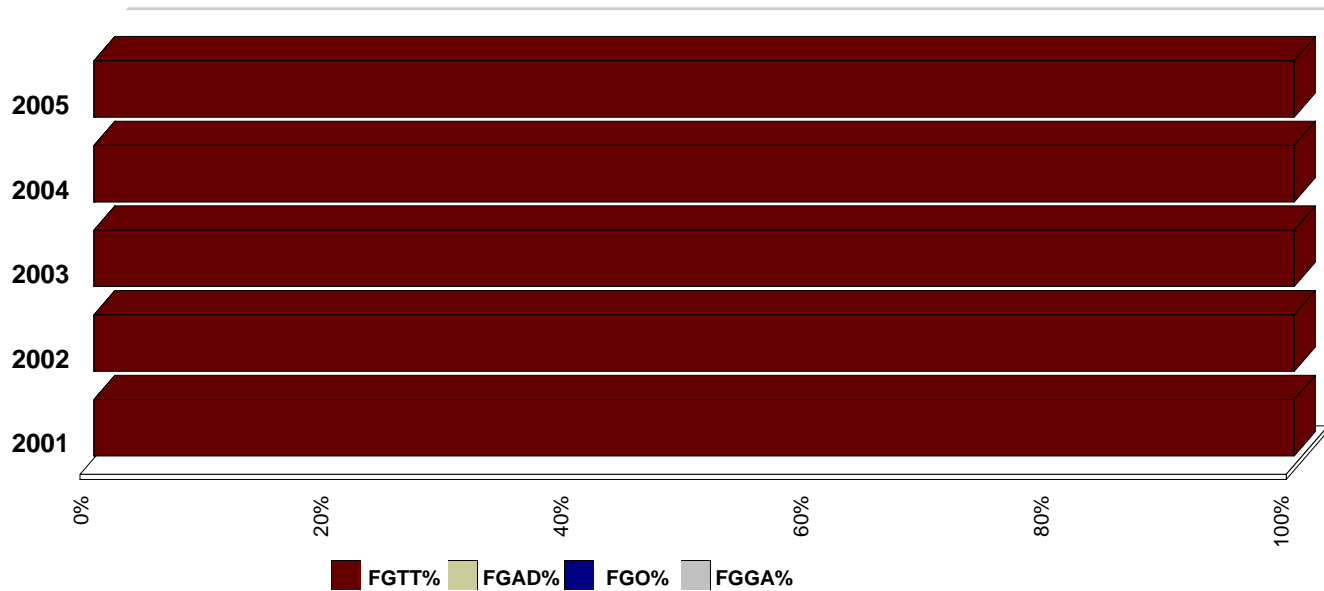

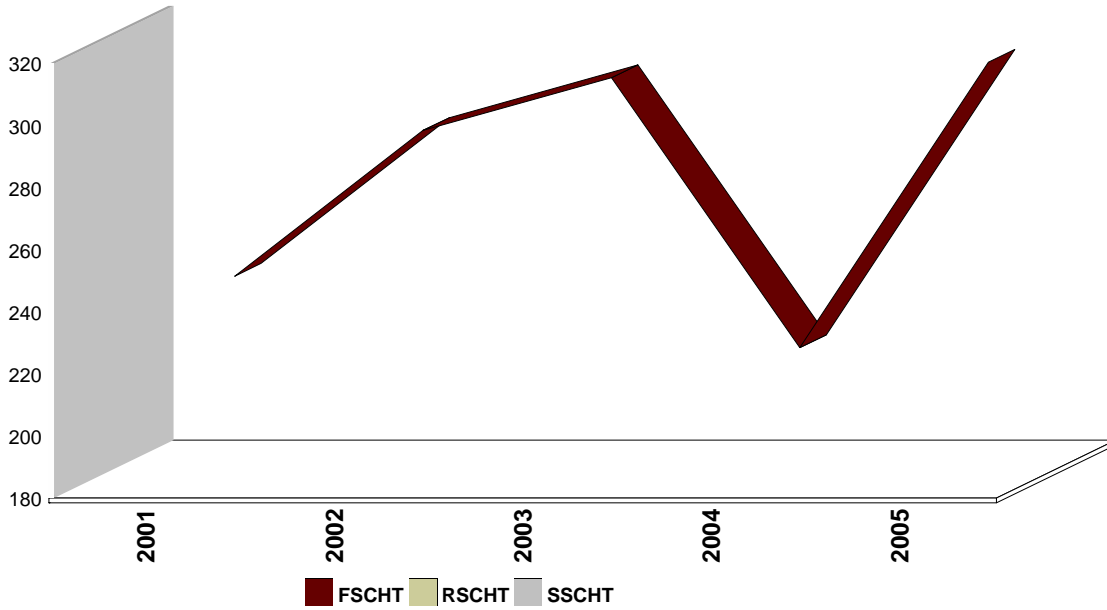

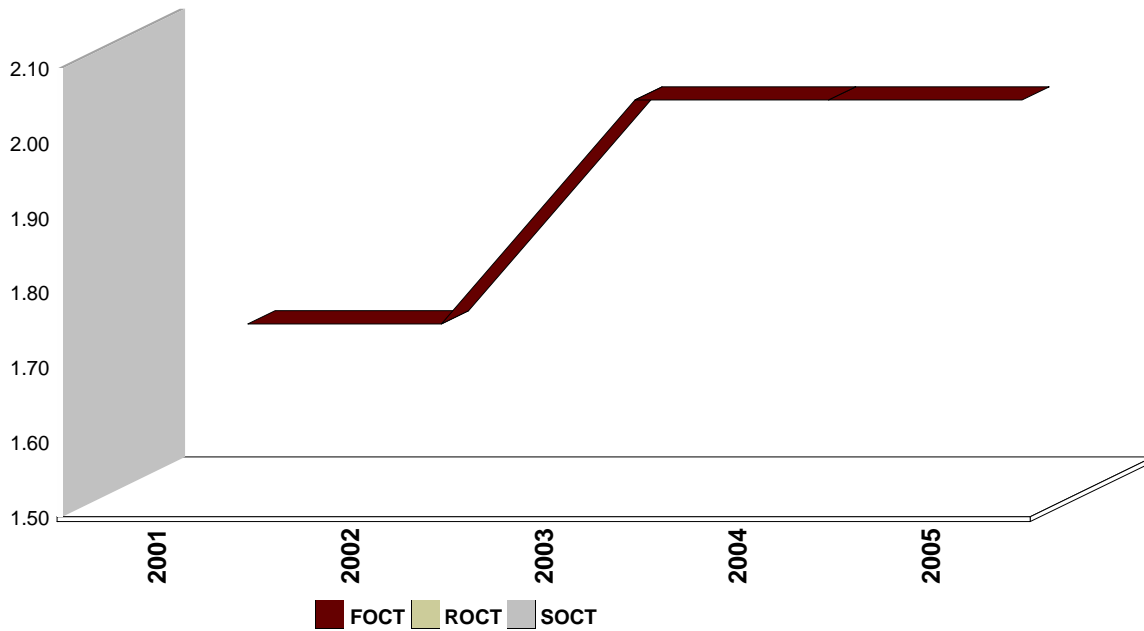

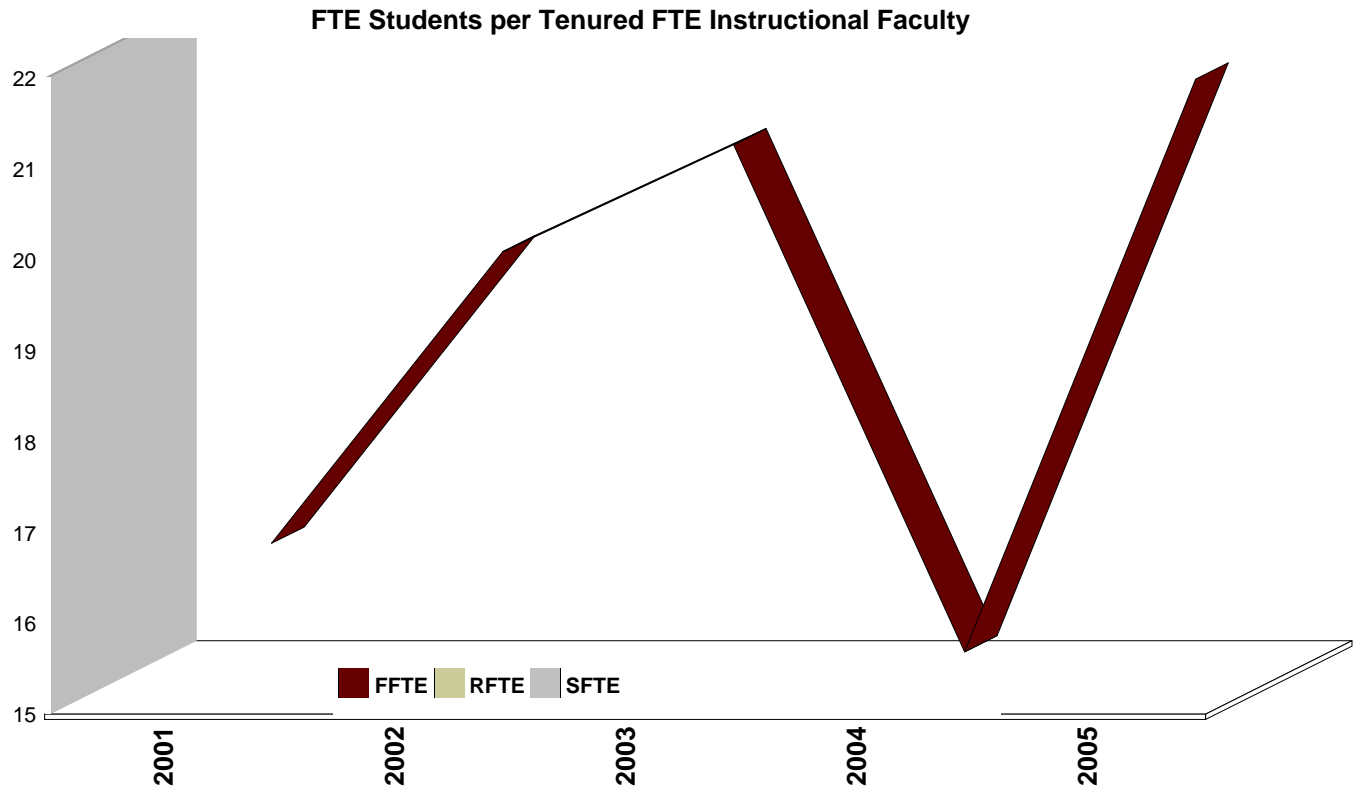
