Enrollment by Fall Semester



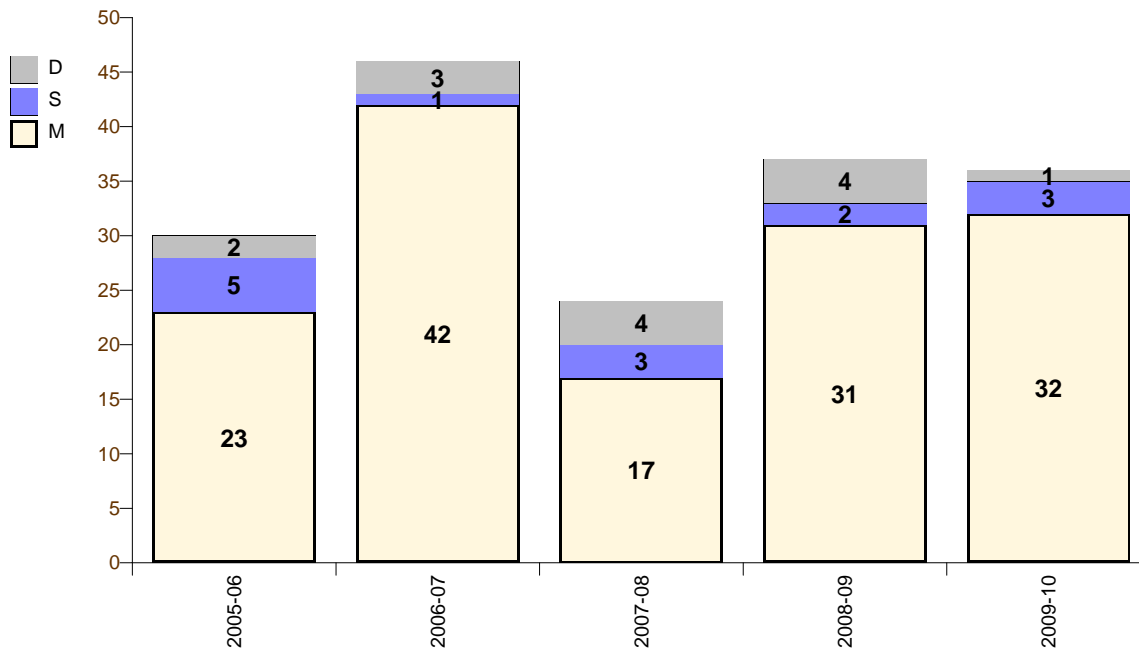
