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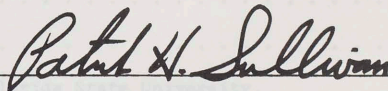
FOREWORD

This ten-year fact book has been compiled for the purpose of providing a convenient and authoritative source of factual information concerning various aspects of the Florida State University during the 1960's. This was a decade which saw a period of unprecedented growth for both the State of Florida and the Florida State University. The operations of a major university are far too numerous and complex to be easily summarized in a manner which will meet the information needs of all interested persons. However, it is hoped that this book will serve as a frequent resource reference for interested administrators, faculty, staff, students, and friends of the University.

This book is arranged in six parts, and each part concerns a separate topic area related to the university. Within each of these parts there are several tables containing various types of information on the particular topic area.

In some instances, the data presented are as detailed as the source will allow.

It is hoped that as the recipients of this book examine its contents, they will make suggestions as to additions or modifications of future Florida State University Fact Books. PART ONE

History and Government

In 1822 the legislature of the State of Florida established two colleges, one to be located east and one west of the Apalachicola River.

As an instrument to place one of these institutions in Tallahassee, the Board of Trustees of the Florida Institute offered the legislature a new building and campus. When the legislature accepted the offer, the legislature passed an act in 1824 to establish the Florida State College for Women in Tallahassee. The college was opened in 1825 and continued in operation until 1845.

In 1845 the state institutions of higher learning, including the Florida State College, were discontinued. In their place, two institutions were established—a university for men and a college for women. The management of these institutions was vested in a Board of Control. The Board of Control was the State Board of Education until 1865 when it was reorganized. The college for women became the Florida State College for Women in the fall of 1845.

On May 15, 1847, the Governor signed a bill passed by the legislature which established the Florida State College for Women. The college was opened in 1848 and continued in operation until 1865.

1865, in the fall of 1865, had an enrollment of more than 17,000 resident students and included the following divisions: College of Arts and Sciences, College of Education, School of Law, School of Medicine, School of Engineering, School of Business, School of Nursing, School of Music, School of Fine Arts, School of Social Welfare, College of Law, and the Office of the Director of Research and Graduate Work.

Graduate programs include work toward master's and doctor's degrees.

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HISTORY OF THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY

In 1851 the Legislature of the State of Florida provided for the establishment of two state colleges, one to be located east and one west of the Suwannee River.

As an inducement to place one of these institutions at Tallahassee, the Board of Trustees of the Florida Institute offered the Legislature a new building and property for the school, appraised at ten thousand dollars. The Legislature accepted this offer in January, 1857. In February of that year the Seminary West of the Suwannee River was opened at Tallahassee. The institution later became the Florida State College and continued in operation until 1905.

In 1905 six state institutions of higher learning, including the Florida State College, were discontinued. In their place, two institutions were established--a university for men and a college for women. The management of these institutions was vested in a Board of Control. The Board of Control and the State Board of Education met in joint session and decided to locate the college for women in Tallahassee. Florida State College became Florida State College for Women in the Fall of 1905.

On May 15, 1947, the Governor signed a bill passed by the Legislature making the Florida State College for Women coeducational and changing its name to The Florida State University.

FSU, in the Fall of 1970, had an enrollment of more than 17,200 resident students and included the following divisions: College of Arts and Sciences, College of Education, School of Home Economics, the Library School, School of Engineering Science, School of Nursing, School of Music, School of Business, School of Social Welfare, College of Law, and the Office of the Director of Research and Graduate Dean.

Graduate programs include work toward master's and doctor's degrees.

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State Board of Education

In the fall of 1968, the people of Florida changed the composition of the State Board of Education to consist of the Governor, the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, the State Treasurer, the Commissioner of Education, the Comptroller, and the Commissioner of Agriculture. The Governor is the Chairman of the State Board of Education and the Commissioner of Education serves as secretary and executive officer.

The State Board of Education determines policies, adopts rules and regulations, prescribes minimum standards, performs duties and exercises responsibilities assigned to it by law or "as it may find necessary for the improvement of the state system of public education in carrying out the purposes and objectives of the school code." The State Board of Education exercises "such control and supervision over the institutions under the management and control of the State Board of Education as may be deemed proper by said State Board of Education with due regard to the highest interest of education." The State Board of Education supervises the work of the Board of Regents as prescribed by law.

Board of Regents

By legislative act, the Board of Control became the Board of Regents on January 1, 1965. The 1965 Legislature created the position of Chancellor for the state-wide university system. The Board of Regents consists of nine citizens of the State of Florida appointed by the Governor to staggered nine-year terms. The Board of Regents is at all times under and subject to the control and supervision of the State Board of Education.

The Board of Regents has jurisdiction and complete management and control over the following institutions: the University of Florida, the Florida State University, the Florida Atlantic University, the University of South Florida, the Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University, the University of West Florida, the Florida Technological University, and the extension activities of the universities. (The University of North Florida and Florida International University will open to students in 1972.)

The Board of Regents is invested with full power and authority to make all rules and regulations necessary for the governing of the institutions when these rules and regulations are not inconsistent with rules and regulations of the State Board of Education.

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The Board of Regents appoints all officers, managers, faculty, teachers, servants, and employees and has authority to remove those who, in its judgment and discretion, should be removed. It sets compensation and provides for payment. It controls the lands, buildings, structures, and property belonging to the institutions over which it has jurisdiction. It supervises all budgets, finances, and expenditures. It has control of all buildings and properties and may purchase and acquire land and property necessary for the operation of the institutions which it controls.

GLOSSARY

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ACADEMIC RANK - - - - See "Faculty Rank"

ACADEMIC YEAR - - - - The time period containing the academic sessions held during consecutive Fall, Winter, and Spring months. Usually 9 or 10 months in length, and normally runs from September to June.

ALLOCATED POSITIONS - - The staff or faculty employment positions allotted for each fiscal year in the University Operating Budget. An allocated position exists whether it is filled with an employee or not.

FACULTY RANK- - - - - A state-wide categorization of faculty positions. Categories include Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, and Instructor.

FISCAL YEAR - - - - - A twelve-month time period running from July 1st through the following June 30th.

FULL-TIME-EQUIVALENT

(F.T.E.) FACULTY- - - - A budgetary term that represents one full-time faculty position.
Note that two people each serving in half-time faculty positions would together equal one F.T.E. faculty.

FULL-TIME-EQUIVALENT

(F.T.E.) STUDENT- - - - A budgetary term that represents one student carrying a full, normal academic load. Under the quarter system, an undergraduate student carrying 15 credit hours/quarter is considered one F.T.E. student.

GENERAL CLASSROOM - - - Rooms used by classes which do not require special-purpose equipment for student use.

HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT- - The actual number of individual students enrolled at a specified time period regardless of whether the students are attending full-time or part-time.

- HEADCOUNT FACULTY - - - The number of individual persons who are members of the faculty. Includes both part-time and full-time individuals.
- LEVEL OF STUDENT- - - Reflects a student's level of progress toward a degree. Freshmen and Sophomore students are categorized in the Lower Level; Junior and Senior students are categorized in the Upper Level; Graduate students are categorized in the Graduate Level.
- SEMINAR ROOM- - - - Rooms used by seminar-type classes which do not require special-purpose equipment for student use.
- STUDENT LEVEL - - - - See "Level of Student".
- TEACHING AUDITORIUMS- - Rooms designed especially to accommodate larger lecture-type classes. Rooms in this category usually have fixed seating and stage areas.
- TEACHING LABORATORY - - Rooms used by classes which require special-purpose equipment for student participation, experimentation, observation, or practice in a field of study.
