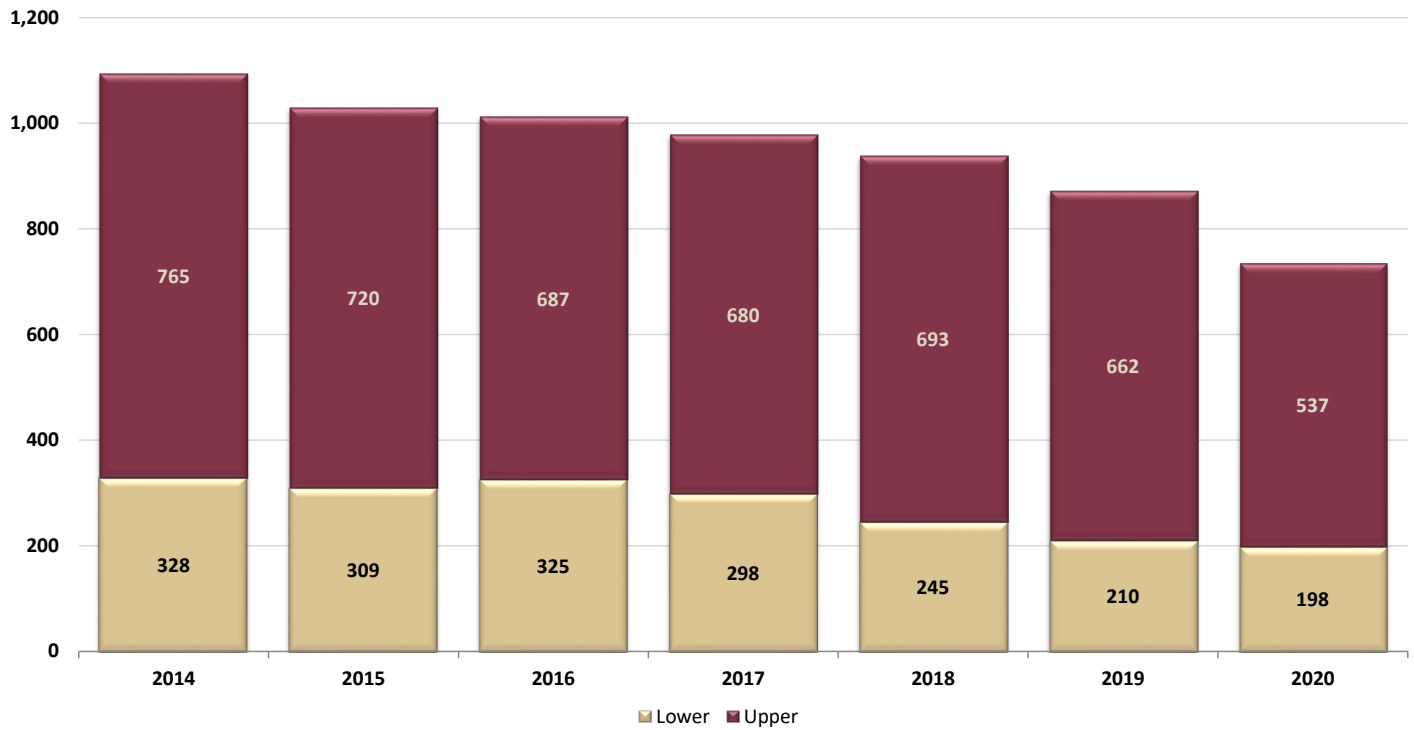

Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment by Class Level

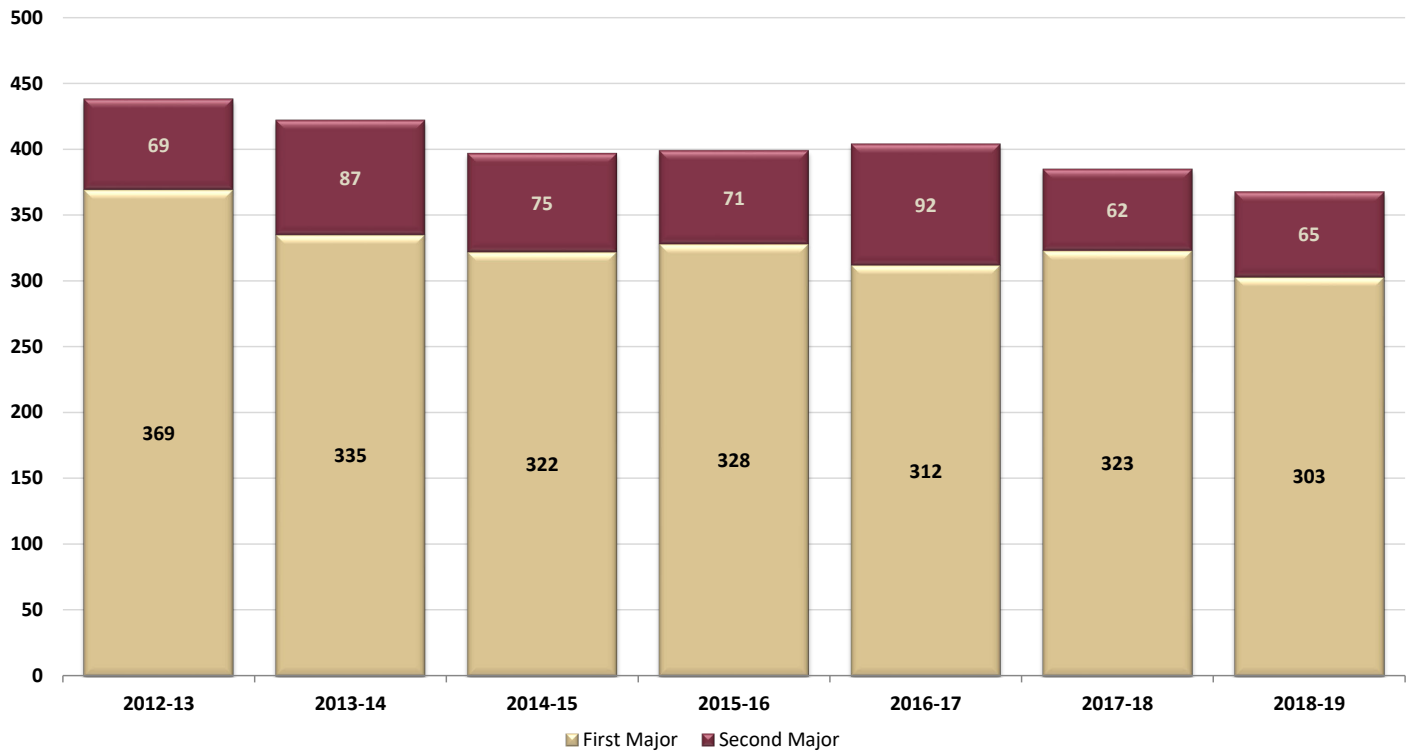

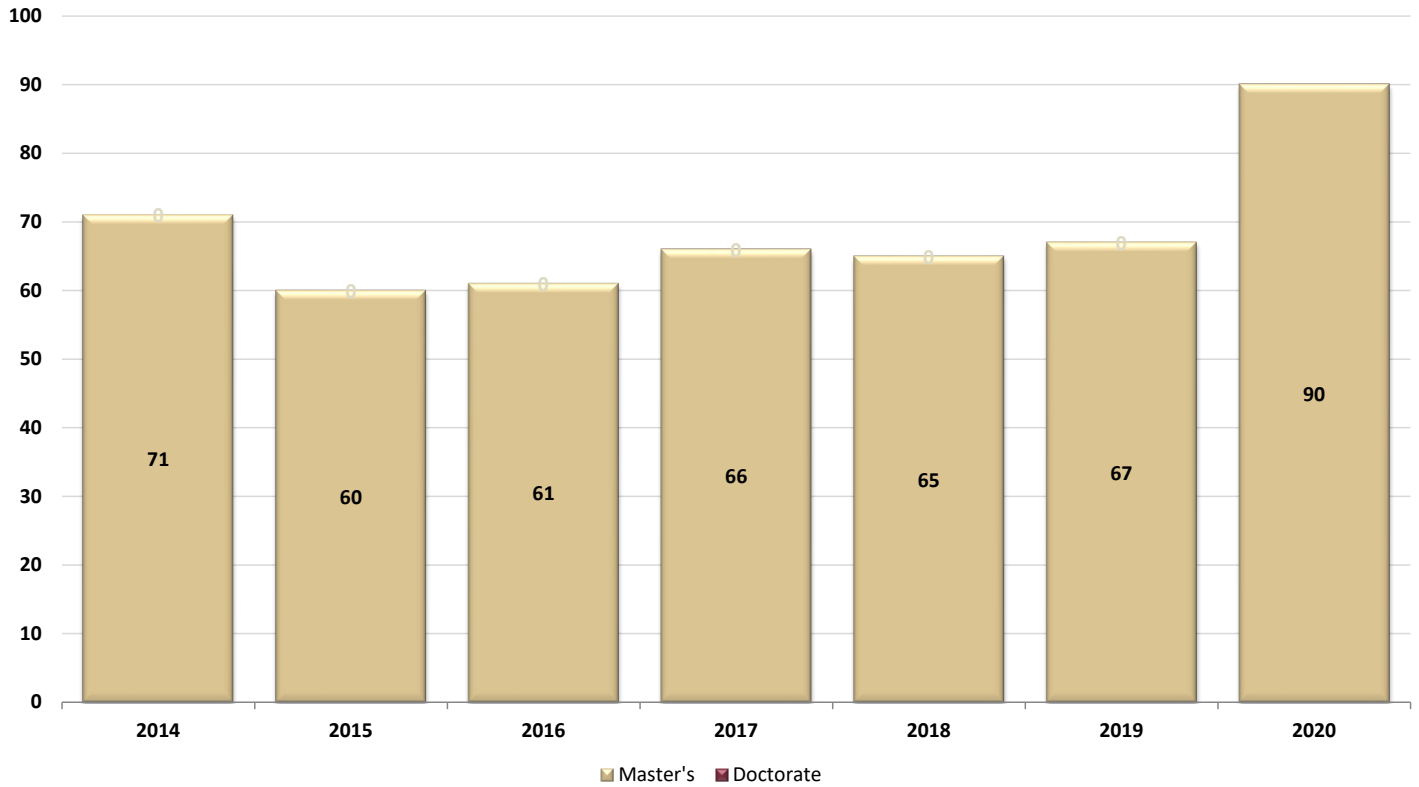

Graduate Headcount Enrollment by Degree Level Sought

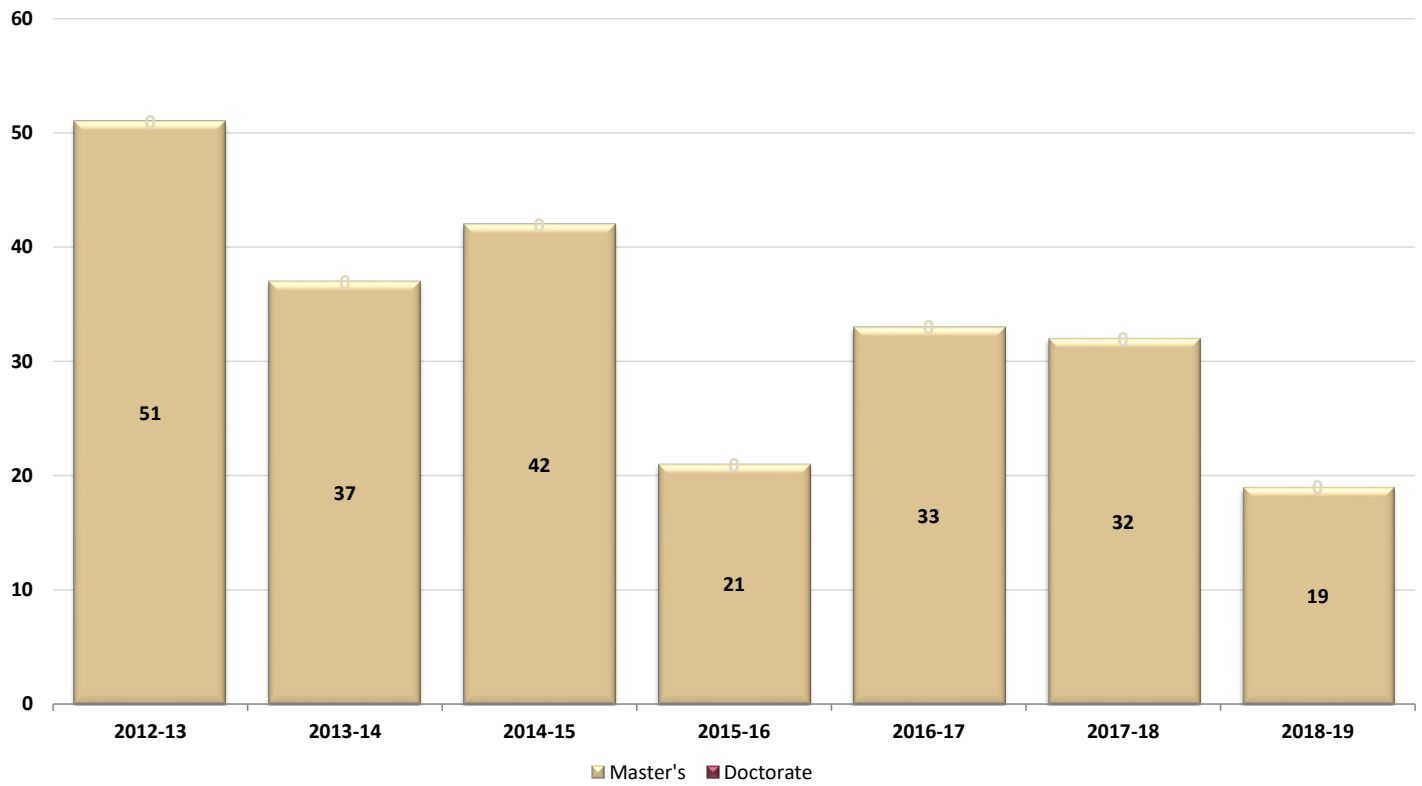
